Remembrance Day Service

On Friday, November 10, St. Luke Catholic School will be holding a Remembrance Day Service at 10:45 a.m. in the gym.

The Grade 4 classes will be leading this presentation for the whole school. All of the students will be seated at the front, and they will have a variety of different roles to fill, such as:

- Most of the children will have a short reading to read at the microphone. Early next week they will bring home a slip with their reading so they can practice. Could you please rehearse the text with your child? Although the words do not have to be memorized, familiarity with the message will allow your child to read at the microphone from the good-copy card in a relaxed and confident manner.
- Some students will participate in a dramatic tableau set to the poem “In Flanders’ Fields”.
- A few students will be bringing up the class wreaths in a symbolic wreath-laying ceremony.
